The program objectives of “Where Does Your Money Go?” are to:

- Understand how their current money-management practices affect their financial stability.
- Increase their knowledge of money-management practices that lead to financial control.
- Establish financial management practices that promote financial stability, such as: tracking expenses, identifying spending leaks, identifying needs vs. wants, establishing written financial goals, and developing a spending-saving plan.

Identify adopted financial management practices and recognize the economic impact of new practices

Through hands-on activities, participants will analyze current spending patterns to determine ways to adjust spending in order to stabilize personal finances. Participants will demonstrate their understanding of proven financial strategies by tracking expenses, writing financial goals, and developing spending-savings plans.
