Entry Fee: \$4/class Office fee: \$2/horse

Entries must be made no later than three (3) classes prior to start. NO REFUNDS!!

Must be three entries in class or may be combined.

Note: Only one animal per exhibitor per class-no exceptions!

There is a separate judge for Trail and Dressage classes that will run concurrent with other classes.

Points for county teams will be given as follows: 1st place-6 points; 2nd place-5 points; 3rd place-4 points; 4th place-3 points; 5th place-2 points; 6th place-1 point.

4-H'ers must show for the county in which they are currently enrolled.

Walk trot exhibitors may show in walk-trot classes, halter, and showmanship classes only.

The winning team will win \$250 gift towards an education speaker for their show participants.
