Classes

1. Showmanship
2. Trail
3. Western Horsemanship
4. English Pleasure
5. Barrels

- * You may show in all five of the classes above. You will only be scored on four classes. The four classes that you place the highest in will be the classes that determine your score (i.e. you may drop one class). You may choose to show in only four classes. Those four classes will determine your score.
- * Juniors and Seniors will be judged together, but scored separately.
- * Each participant must have two helpers (4-H member and/or family member): one for clothes and tack changes and one to hold the animal.
- * Participants will have 5 minutes to change their clothes and tack between classes. You must walk to the truck that is carrying your tack - **NO RUNNING!**
- * Once the contest begins, the participants cannot leave the ring until placings are announced. All tack and attire must be on a truck **BEFORE** the contest begins. No additions or removal of tack or attire from your truck after contest begins. Be sure you have everything you need for all tack and attire changes before the contest begins!
- * Drivers of tack trucks must be **18 years of age or older**.
- * You must wear an approved helmet in all mounted classes.
- * Any infractions of the above rules will disqualify the participant.

SCORING

- * Exhibitors will be placed through tenth place in each class. Points will be awarded according to place (1st = 1 point, 2nd = 2 points . . . 10th = 10 points). Exhibitors below 10th place will receive 11 points. Exhibitors who are disqualified will receive 12 points.
- * Overall placing will be made with the lower total as the higher place.
- * In the event of a tie, the tie will be broken first on the most first places, secondly on placing in the most classes, and thirdly on better score in fifth class.

ENTRIES

- * Pre-entry deadline is Tuesday, July 21st at the entry booth. Post entries accepted up to the night before the contest. **Money must accompany entry.**
