**NOVICE SHOWMANSHIP**

If showing in Novice Showmanship, you may not show in any other showmanship class.

**SMALL FRY LEAD-LINE SHOWMANSHIP**

Small Fry Showmanship is for children enrolled in Mini 4-H Horse & Pony. An adult family member must have the animal on a lead while in the show ring.

**MASTER SHOWMANSHIP**

Master Showmanship is open to any Senior 4-H Horse & Pony member wishing to compete for the opportunity to represent Horse & Pony in the Johnson County Master Showmanship Contest. The winner of this title MUST exhibit at the county contest during fair week. They are responsible for learning how to show all other livestock species prior to the county contest. You may exhibit your horse or pony in either Western or English attire.

**NOVICE WALK-TROT**

If showing in these classes, rider may not show in any other performance class, except Novice Walk/Trot classes, in that discipline. Not eligible for class #23 & #75.

**NOVICE JR WESTERN PLEASURE/NOVICE SR WESTERN PLEASURE**

If showing in Novice Western Pleasure, you may not show in any other pleasure class, except class #27.

**GAITED/SADDLE TYPE WESTERN PLEASURE**

If showing in Gaited/Saddle Type Western Pleasure, you may not show in ANY other pleasure class.

**SMALL FRY LEAD-LINE WALK-TROT HORSEMANSHIP/EQUITATION**

Small Fry Walk-Trot Horsemanship/Equitation is for children enrolled in Mini-4-H Horse & Pony. An adult family member must have the animal on a lead while in the show ring.

**JR TRAIL/SR TRAIL/NOVICE WALK-TROT TRAIL**

These classes will be judged in the makeup arena following the lunch break. Listen to announcer for location and times.

**BEGINNER JUMPING**

If showing in beginner jumping, you may not show in any other jumping class.

**NOVICE ENGLISH PLEASURE/EQUITATION**

If showing in this class, you may not show in any other non-novice performance/equitation class.

**WESTERN PLEASURE 5 YRS and UNDER**

(#26) is based on age of animal. Rider may show in one other Western Pleasure class based on rider's age and size of animal. Only ONE Western Pleasure class counts towards points.
