

Boone County Open Llama/Alpaca Show

General Show Information

- Check-in will take place at the horse barn on Tuesday, July 28th from 7:30 – 9:30 PM and Wednesday, July 29th from 7:00 – 8:00 AM.
- This show is open to any llama/alpaca exhibitor in or out of the state of Indiana who meets the age requirements for any class he/she enters.
- This show is divided into Pre-Junior Youth and Open sections. The Pre-Junior Youth section is open to exhibitors who have not yet entered third grade in school. The Open Section is open to all exhibitors who have been in third grade or above, including adults.
- Females, males and non-breeding llamas and alpacas, registered and non-registered, are all eligible for entry. Intact Males 2 years old and older must be shown by exhibitors ages 16 and above.
- Any unruly animal will be asked to leave the show arena.
- Animals may be shown once per class in each section.
- All fees must be paid in cash at the time of entry. No pre-entry is required. Entry forms will be available in the horse barn of the Boone County 4-H Fairgrounds at the time of check-in. Exhibitors who contact Carol Haughton at 765-482-7842 or carrollhaughton@hotmail.com with intended numbers of entries on or before Sunday, July 26th will receive a \$3.00 discount off total entry fees.
- Boone County Fairgrounds is located at 1300 E. 100 S. Lebanon, IN. Animals will enter thru the East Gate near the Horse Arena.

Sections and Classes

- Classes available to the Pre-Junior Youth will be showmanship and obstacle.
- Classes available in the Open Section will be showmanship, halter, obstacle, public relations, pack, ground driving, driving, and costume.
- Llamas and alpacas not also being shown in the Boone County 4-H show may be housed in stalls in the Horse Barn. The stall fee is \$5.00 for each stall. Exhibitors must provide their own bedding and must clean their stalls completely before departing from the fairgrounds.
- Certificates of Veterinary Inspection are not required, per Board of Animal Health requirements. However, all animals will be inspected for signs of communicable disease. Any animal deemed unhealthy for any reason will not be allowed to unload from the trailer and will not be allowed to participate in the show.
