

**Johnson County Farm Bureau, Inc.

Due March 1st to the Johnson County Extension Office.

Johnson County Farm Bureau, Inc. will award up to two scholarships of up to \$1000 each which will be given to Johnson County students who meet the following criteria and are selected.

Eligibility:

The applicant must be a current or past 4-H and/or FFA for at least two years and at least 17 years of age. The applicant's immediate family must currently be a paid member of Johnson County Farm Bureau, Inc. and have been a member for a period of 2 years prior to application. Additionally, the applicant must be a high school senior or recent high school graduate, admitted to an approved or accredited school of higher learning and planning to study a minimum of one year as a full-time student. The applicant does not have to be a first year student; however, preference will be given to an applicant who is not a previous winner of this scholarship.

Criteria:

Applicant shows:

- 1) Involvement and leadership skills in all activities.**
- 2) Determination to succeed in the applicant's chosen field.**
- 3) "C" average or above**
- 4) Paid family membership in Johnson County Farm Bureau, Inc. for two years.**
- 5) Current or past membership in 4-H and/or FFA for at least two years.**

These scholarships are sponsored by Johnson County Farm Bureau, Inc. and will be presented at High School Award Ceremonies and the Johnson County Fair.
