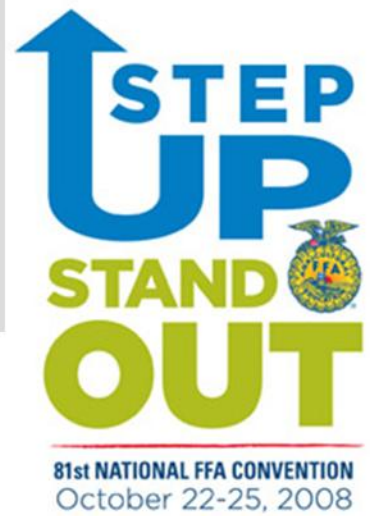


NATIONAL FFA CONVENTION

September has arrived and the National FFA planning for the Nursery/Landscape Career Development Event (October 22-23) is in full swing. Many volunteers will be needed to help serve as judges and assistants for the scheduled competitions.

Thursday, October 23 = 8:00 AM - 2:30 PM

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Do I need judging and/or related work experience?

No. On each day, there will be a brief training session prior to the day's events. Note that judging is primarily based on the presentation of materials (written or oral) whether it be individually or as a team, not necessarily on content.

I'm able to volunteer but my time is limited. Can I just work one day?

Yes. We appreciate any time that you can volunteer (one or both days). However, due to the length of time for many activities, it would be preferred if you stay for the duration of the volunteer time slots, particularly on Wednesday. For Thursday., we may be able to provide a bit more flexibility for those only able to work in the AM. A catered box lunch is provided for those judges and assistants working the full shift on Thursday.



Please advise as to which day you are able to work. When responding, also provide a reachable phone number should I need to contact you with any last minute details. As we near the event I will continue to be in contact with those able to volunteer for confirmation and sharing of updated event information.
