

ORA V. CALLAHAN 4-H AWARD

Callahan, a former 4-H member, Junior Leader, Adult Leader, 1961 State 4-H Alumni winner and now a 4-H supporter, will present six (6) awards each year to outstanding 4-H members in Hancock County. This program was initiated in 1963. These permanent trophies will be presented to the outstanding boy and girl in each of the following classifications listed:

Best 4-H Achievement Record
Best 4-H Citizenship Record
Best 4-H Leadership Record

Objectives of the awards are:

1. Encourage 4-H members to stay in 4-H
2. Provide incentive for 4-H members
3. Encourage 4-H records
4. Build blue ribbon members as well as blue ribbon projects

The County Extension Office will supervise the program and select winners. A previous winner will not be eligible to win the same award again.
