MANUALS: Bicycle 1-Bicycling for Fun (BU-8334), Bicycle 2-Wheels in Motion (BU-8335).

JUDGING TIME: Thursday, July 9, 2009 at 6:00 P.M. (Livestock Pavilion)

STATE FAIR ENTRY: One state fair entry in the junior division and one state fair entry in the senior division.

The County Bike rodeo will be divided into two (2) categories; Juniors: Grades 3 – 7 and Seniors: Grades 8 – 12.

ALL DIVISIONS:

1. Every 4-H Bicycle member should receive a copy of the bicycle rodeo rules, sample test questions, and driving course outline in June.
2. Also, each member should receive manual; as questions on test can come from every manual.
3. Complete suggested activities in your project manual.
4. All riders will take a written exam and a test on parts, tools, and accessories.
 - a. All quiz questions will be from the 4-H bicycle manuals.
 - b. State traffic rules and regulations pertaining to the operation of bicycles will be covered.
5. Complete a maintenance-safety check.
6. All riders will be required to wear a safety helmet in the rodeo.

EXHIBIT: Participate in the County 4-H Bicycle Rodeo and bike inspection at the Howard County 4-H Fair. Turn in a completed bicycle project record sheet in back of manual.
