

HOWARD COUNTY 4-H JUNIOR LEADER SCHOLARSHIP

Due: May 15, 2009

Read and following all guideline and requirements before submitting an application.

1. Eligibility

- A. High School Senior enrolling in college for the first time this year.
- B. Must have completed at least three (3) years in Junior Leadership, including the year in which you are applying for the scholarship.
- C. Must have completed at least five (5) years in 4-H club work, including the year in which you are applying for the scholarship.
- D. Met all Junior Leader guidelines of eligibility for awards & recognitions.
- E. Must be enrolled in an institute of higher learning (does NOT include correspondence schools) for the upcoming fall semester.

2. Selection

- A. Grades
- B. Outstanding 4-H work and Junior Leader work.
- C. Selection made by the Junior Leader advisors.

3. Scholarship Amount

The amount of the scholarship will be determined by the funds raised through the current year's 4-H Ambassador Contest.

4. Notification

Recipients will be notified in the fall of the current year. The scholarship money will be given in January of the following year, once proof of completion of one semester is provided by a copy of grades for the first semester or any other proof completion.

Submit the following to the Extension Office by May 15, 2009:

- I. Completed application.
- II. Transcript of grades.
- III. Letter of recommendation from your high school counselor or principal.
